



For those who wish to work in Japanese Industry

The Front Office for Human Resource Education and Development has a special team to support DC & PDs career development and has relationships with many Japanese companies.

As we talk with the company representatives, most of them require their employees and applicants to have some level of Japanese language proficiency.

This means that, even if you are enrolled in an English graduate course in Hokkaido University, it is strongly recommended that you start or continue to learn Japanese language, if you are intend to work in Japan.

Hokkaido university has a high quality Japanese language course for free and I-HoP supports internation students to take Japanese language proficiency test. On the other hand you can find useful apps with your smartphone.

Just start and keep learning, it will expand your future in Japan.

To make a reservation, email to I-HoP with your name, faculty and expected month/year of graduation.


Career consultation is conducted in a private one-to-one setup or online conference to help you clarify and identify your career objective, or obtain necessary information related to your job hunting, especially in Japan.

It is highly recommended to take this session sooner, like while you are in D1, than later since the recruiting process in Japan starts at least 12 months before your graduation.
